Be Wise. Winterize.

Ready for another Southern Georgian Bay winter? It's a good idea to "winterize" your vehicle with a Maintenance Check at OK Tire Thornbury. Our service includes:

Brakes:

inspect for wear & even braking

Heating & Cooling System:

inspect antifreeze level, radiator, belts, hoses, water pump, thermostat

Battery & Electrical System:

inspect battery charge, fluid levels, connections, voltage regulator, alternator/generator

Engine:

if your "check engine" light is on, it shouldn't be; perform engine diagnostic; tune up if necessary

Exhaust System:

inspect muffler & tail pipe for leaks

Ignition System:

inspect ignition wires, spark plugs

Heater, Defroster, Wipers:

ensure all are working properly; install winter wiper blades as required

Lights:

inspect all vehicle lights front & back including headlight aim

Tires:

inspect for proper pressure and wear; install winter tires for safer driving

Apples Everywhere!

It's apple season, and here's an excellent recipe from Kevin's mom, Donna Shaw, who's apple pie won 1st prize at the Beaver Valley Fall Fair.

Mrs. Shaw's Apple Recipe:

Pastry for a double crust pie
5 tart apples - or enough to fill shell

Mix together 1 cup white sugar and 1 tbsp cornstarch (you can add cinnamon & nutmeg here if desired) and 2 tablespoons butter. Peel & slice apples. Place in shell alternately with sugar/cornstarch mixture. Dot with butter. Place top crust over apples. Bake at 450° for 10 minutes. Reduce heat to 350 degrees for 40 minutes.
