Something Tasty is Springing Up

Celebrate spring and enjoy fresh local asparagus with this delicious recipe.

Lemon Zest Asparagus

- 1 bunch medium-sized asparagus
- 2 tbsp extra virgin olive oil
- 2 tbsp freshly-grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 tsp freshly-grated lemon rind

Directions:

1. Rinse asparagus thoroughly. Break off tough white ends and cut remaining stalks diagonally into 1-2 inch pieces.
2. In a medium saucepan filled half way with boiling water, parboil asparagus for 2 minutes.
3. Drain hot water and put asparagus in a bowl.
4. Toss hot asparagus with olive oil, cheese and lemon zest. Add salt and pepper to taste.
5. Serve warm or at room temperature.
